Responsibilities

Connecting and Discipling

- In coordination with the Ministry to Women Board, create, design and develop connection environments to connect women into deeper involvement into the church strategy, to each other, and to places of service.
- Be an approachable, authentic and humble woman, building relationships with women across all ministries.
- Pursue women in a relational way that communicate care and a desire for their growth
- Engage in equipping, empowering and deploying women of all generations to live out their full God-given potential, connecting their gifts and passion to service inside and outside the church.
- Be the social connection for women at events, worship service Sunday mornings, and as needed.
- Partner with local ministries to women build relational bridges for the expansion of the kingdom

Serving Northwest through Group Life

- Be a key member of Group Life, helping fulfill the strategy of groups for the church and a catalyst for the Group Life Playbook.
- Serve on the Women's Ministry Board and in coordination with Minister to Women.
- Engage in staff and key leader meetings, specifically the Story Board.
- Develop strategic partnerships to help maximize the ministry to women with organizations that serve women inside and outside the Church.
- Serve as an available guide to direct women with counseling needs to the appropriate resources.
- Other responsibilities as required.

Requirements
